SOCIAL SECURITY (CLAIMS AND PAYMENTS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2019,

and shall be read and construed as one with the Social Security (Claims and Payments) Regulations, which, as amended, are hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 11 of the principal Regulations is amended—

Amendment of regulation 11.

- (a) in sub-regulation (1) by repealing paragraph (a) and substituting the following-
 - "(a) in the case of sickness or injury benefit-
 - (i) the period of two weeks from the first day of sickness or injury; and

- (ii) the period of six months from the first day of sickness or injury for any subsequent claims in relation to that sickness or injury;"; and
- (b) in sub-regulation (2) by repealing paragraph (a) and substituting the following—
 - "(a) in the case of sickness of injury benefit-
 - (i) benefit in respect of any day more than two weeks before the date on which the claim is made; or
 - (ii) benefit in respect of any day more than six months before the date on which the subsequent claim is made.".

Amendment of regulation 12.

- 3. Regulation 12 of the principal Regulations is amended by inserting immediately after sub-regulation (2) the following as sub-regulations (3) and (4)—
- "(3) Every insured person who fails to give notice of an accident in accordance with this regulation shall be disqualified from receiving an injury benefit.
- (4) Notwithstanding sub-regulation (3), an insured person shall not be disqualified from receiving an injury benefit for failure to give notice of an accident if that insured person proves that there was good cause for the failure in giving notice.".

Negative Resolution. 4. These Regulations are subject to negative resolution.
